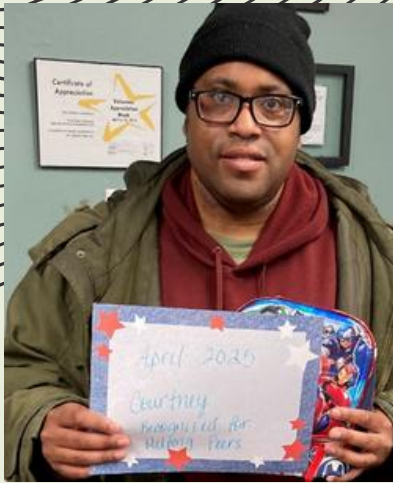


Wisconsin:
